

Government Orders and Circulars

When final decisions of Government are communicated, they have to be embodied in the form of Government Order or Circular. Statutory notifications are also classified as Government Orders for the purpose of correspondence.

When a Government Order does not contain a statement that it is issued as per the order or direction of the Governor, it should be subscribed as 'By order of the Governor'. As all executive actions of Government are undertaken in the name of Governor an order will be *ab initio* void if this indication is not provided.
