വകുപ്പ് 6(3) പ്രകാരം ഒരു പബ്ലിക് ഇൻഫർമേഷൻ ഓഫീസർ മറ്റൊരു പബ്ലിക് ഇൻഫർമേഷൻ ഓഫീസർക്ക് അപേക്ഷ കൈമാറുമ്പോൾ അതോടൊപ്പം നിർദ്ദേശങ്ങളോടൊന്നും നൽകരുത്.

The Commission would also like to advise the CPIO, Cabinet Secretariat that he should not make general statement about the disclosure liability of a given set of information while transferring RTI application under section 6(3) of the RTI Act. Section 6(3) only authorises the public authority to transfer the request for information to another public authority. It does not confer any power on the CPIO to record his view with respect to the information sought in the application, which he is transferring to another public authority. Further the proviso of section 6(3) states that the transfer of an application pursuant to this sub-section shall be made as soon as practicable but in no case later than five days from the date of receipt of the application.
