

ഒരു സ്ഥാപനത്തിന്റെ Proprietor, Managing Director എന്നിങ്ങനെയുള്ള entity യിൽ വിവരാവകാശ നിയമം ഉപയോഗിക്കുവാൻ കഴിയില്ല

The RTI Act, of course, was introduced for setting out the "***practical regime of information for citizens***". Section 3 of the Act further would declare to the whole nation that "***all citizen shall have the right to information***". So right to information is a right, a legal right, rather a fundamental right envisages under Article 19 & 21 of the Constitution of India. It is an individual right conferred to a citizen and, not on any other person, or on any other capacity, as "Proprietor", "Managing Director" and such other entities. The right to information is a right guaranteed to a citizen, primarily in the public interest and, secondly to his own requirements.

Hence all these appeals and complaints are dismissed in-limine.
