

ആധാരത്തിന്റെ സർട്ടിഫൈഡ് പകർപ്പിന് രജിസ്ട്രേഷൻ വകുപ്പിൽ നിലവിലുള്ള ഫീസ് തന്നെ അടയ്ക്കണം

FAA's Order:-

Sub Registrar VII has rightly said that certified copies of the said documents cannot be provided and the same have to be obtained under Registration Act 1908 by paying the prescribed fees. However, normal photocopies can be issued under the RTI Act, 2005 after receipt of prescribed fees. Sub Registrar VII is directed to issue photo copies of the documents required by the appellant by charging the fees applicable under RTI Act. Needful to be done within 05 working days.

Grounds for Second Appeal:

Unsatisfactory information provided by PIO.

Relevant Facts emerging during Hearing:

The following were present

Appellant: Absent;

Respondent: Mr. Daljit Singh, Sub-Registrar-VII on behalf of Mr. S. K. Jha, PIO & SDM(HQ)

The respondent states that the attested photocopies have been supplied to the Appellant on 18/01/2011. This has been acknowledged by the Appellant as well. The Appellant contends that certified copies should have been provided to him. The PIO has stated that for certified copies the Appellant should apply under SR-VII after paying the prescribed fee as per Registration Act 1908. This is the correct position and attested photocopies can be obtained under the RTI Act which have been provided.

Decision:

The appeal is disposed.
