Disposal of Government Gazettes—Rules regarding—
 Notification of—

Read:—(1) Letter No. M7-26574 36 Misc., dated 21-12-1956
 from the Board of Revenue.

(2) Letter No. P2-774/57 dated 22-4-1957 from the
 Superintendent of Government Presses, Trivan-
 drum.

Order No. D. Dis. 2761/57, RD.

According to the Appendix to the Rules dated 14-2-1935
 issued under the Destruction of Records Act II of 1928 (Travan-
 core), the period of preservation of Gazettes is 20 years. The
 Board of Revenue has stated in its letter read as first paper
 above, that the preservation of Gazettes for 20 years contri-
 butes much to the congestion in the Records Room of Sub-
 Offices, which are generally small and that in Madras the Gazet-
 tes are preserved only for 12 years. The Board of Revenue,
therefore, recommends that the period of preservation of Gazet-
tes, fixed in the Appendix to the Rules referred to above, may
be revised and fixed as 12 years.

The Superintendent of Government Presses has stated in his
 letter read as second paper that all Acts, Ordinances, Rules and
 Statutory Notifications etc., published in the Gazettes are being
 issued in separate volumes, after publication in the Gazettes and
 that there is, therefore, no necessity to preserve Gazettes for
 long periods.

In the circumstances, Government agree with the recom-
 mendation of the Board of Revenue and order that the Gazettes
 need be preserved only for 12 years. The Appendix to the Rules
 dated 14-2-1935, issued under the Destruction of Records Act,
 II of 1928 (Travancore) will stand revised accordingly.

The Superintendent of Government Presses, Trivandrum
 will publish this Government Proceedings in the next issue of
 the Gazette.
